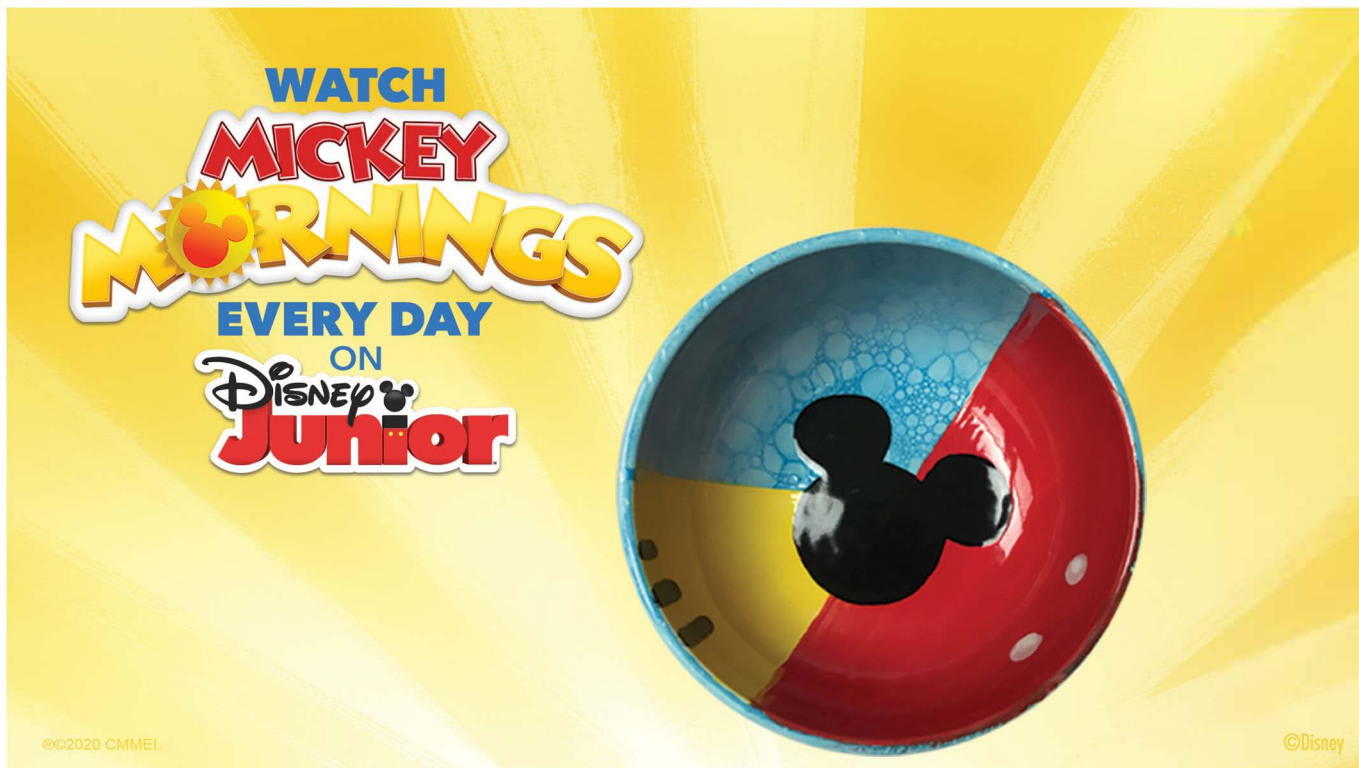

OH BOY! Create a Mickey bowl using bubbles, taping, and tracing techniques.

# MICKEY BOWL



## MATERIALS

- Cereal bowl (SKU DB21446)
  - Fan brush
- Medium round brush
- Small detail brush
  - Tape
  - Dish soap
  - Tablespoon
- Straw (re-usable)
  - Pencil
- Mickey template
- Tracing paper
- Paint:  
62, 85, 46, 98, 31, 67

## TIPS

- Mix water and paint before adding dish soap.
- Allow bubbles to pop on their own.
- Make new bubble mix when applying to the inside of the bowl.
- Let the paint dry completely between coats.
- This technique can be applied to most bowls.

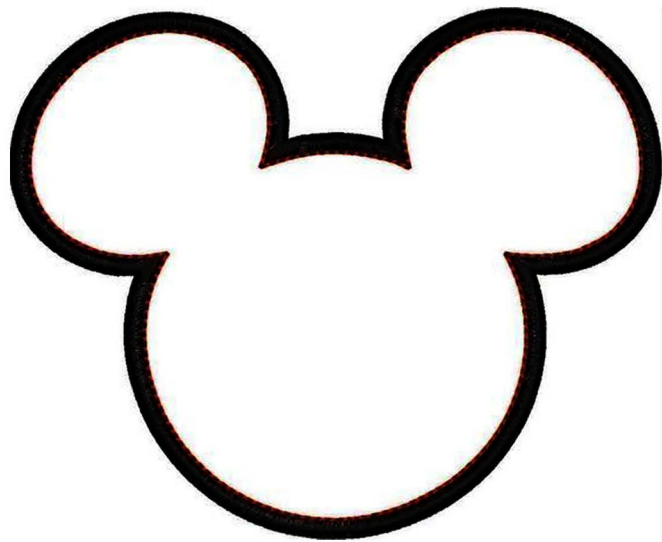
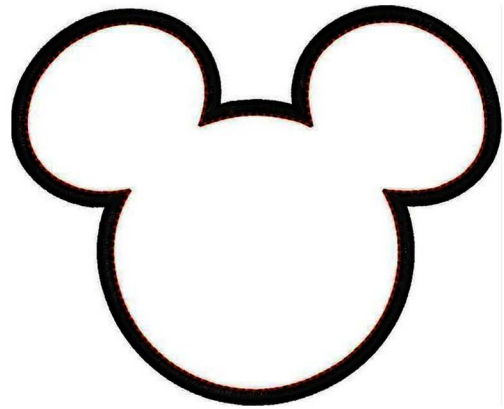

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe bowl clean with damp sponge.
2. Using a fan brush paint the outside of the bowl with #62. (2 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
3. With a medium round brush paint along the edge of the bowl with #62. (2 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
4. Tape a line off center across the inside of the bowl. Tape another line on the larger side to create a triangle. Your bowl should have a small triangle a big triangle and a half circle.
5. Paint the big triangle with #62 using a small round brush. (2 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
6. Make bubble mix with 4 tablespoons of water, 2 tablespoons of paint (#85), and a drop of dish soap. Mix well. Using a straw blow gently into the mix to create bubbles.
7. Flip bowl upside down and carefully place bubbles to the outside of the bowl. Allow the bubbles to pop on their own and dry before turning your bowl over.
8. Add bubbles to the inside of your bowl on the area you've painted. Allow the bubbles to pop and dry.
9. Carefully peel off the tape separating the painted area and the small triangle. With a lightly damp sponge wipe away any paint in the small triangle.
10. Using a medium round brush paint in the small triangle with #46. (3 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
11. Carefully peel off the tape left and wipe away any paint on the half circle with a lightly damp sponge.
12. Using a medium round brush paint in the half circle with #98. (3 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
13. Tape the Mickey Template over tracing paper and trace onto the inside of your bowl. (If the tracing is difficult to see, gently go over it with a pencil.)
14. With a medium round brush paint Mickey with #31.
15. Add 3 horizontal line accents with #31 and a small detail brush midway onto the triangle making one line longer than the other with the top being the shortest. (3 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
16. Create the illusion of Mickey's buttons by dipping your index finger into #67 paint and applying them on the half circle.
