TECHNIQUE: SHAVING CREAM

Create abstract patterns and textures using shaving cream!

MATERIALS

• Ceramic Plate

- Scrap Table Paper • Shaving Cream • Ruler
- Stylus or Skewer • Sink Access
- Underglazes: 35, 41, 83

TIPS

• For best results, limit your colors to three.

• Feel free to experiment with moving the colors around on top of the shaving cream for various marbling effects.

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INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the bisque with a damp sponge to remove dust.

2. Fold up some table paper to make a base for the shaving cream. Make it slightly larger than the size of the piece you will be painting.

3. Apply a layer of shaving cream onto the base and smooth it over with a ruler. It is like icing on top of a cake.

4. Squeeze paints onto the shaving cream one at a time creating swirls or concentric circles of different colors.

5. Move paint on the surface of the shaving cream with a stylus or a skewer. Make lines from the center out and then from the edges back into the center.

6. Place the piece into the painted shaving cream and press down.

7. Remove the paper base and discard it. Wash off the remaining shaving cream using a low pressure stream of water from a faucet in a sink.

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
